




Opportunity for specialized research in Perfins

A Perfin Oddity

The American Appraisal Co. of Milwaukee, besides having a perfin machine of the ordinary kind has another with its full name spelled out in a single line. Sometimes, by mistake, it has been used on the company stamps. Here are some examples.

1		No. 5 is on company cover dated Jun. 28, 1933 from Milwaukee
2		Nos. 2, 3, 4 & 6 are Milwaukee precancels
3		The center hole in the second upright of the N is missing in 3 to 5
4		The second hole in the upright of the R is missing in 5 to 7
5		No. 2 is erroneously listed in the catalog.
6		Nos. 2 & 7 from Travell's collection
7		Research by A.S. Bartleson
