Among the publications noted by the editor are the following:

- Daggs- Stamp Review May 1938, p.22 and July 1938; A list of 30 known values of Canadian official perfins in the 5hi type.
- Gould- Gibbons Stamp Monthly Jan. 1951, p.53 Adventures in forming a collection based on a large quantity of G.B. "Penny Lilacs", Perfins inc.
- Earl- Stamp Lover Jan. 1945, p.113-4. Guatemala, Perforated "Official" issues 1902-27. A list by S.G. catalog numbers of issues that were so perforated, including some hand-stamped types made while the perforator was damaged. The issues were said to be rather carefully controlled and nearly free of errors. Perforating was done in blocks of 4.
- Woolley- B.N.A. Topics, June & July 1950 & 202-3. Canadian Perfins, Government Types and WP/&/YR
- Anon. Commonwealth of Australia Bull.#4, Feb. 1954 Reprinted in Stamp Mag.(Lon.) May 1954, p.369. The First Punctured OS Stamps of Australia. A detailed historical study of the first use of OS stamps in each of the Australian states with references to other perforations used until the adoption of the OS.
- Jordan- Phil. Adviser, Nov. 1953 p.29-31. Ox. Univ. Soc. on the Rose Red Stars. The beginning of an interesting study on these predecessors of Perfins.
- VanLint- Mijn Stokpaardje Jun. 1954 p.78-80 Company Perfins. A general discussion
